Peter Norton Ph. D, is the author of <u>Fighting Traffic: The Dawn of the Motor Age in the American</u> <u>City</u> (MIT Press), and of <u>Autonorama: The Illusory Promise of High-Tech Driving</u> (Island Press, 2021).He is associate professor of history in the Department of Engineering and Society at the University of Virginia, where he teaches history of technology, social dimensions of engineering, research, and professional ethics.

Meredith Richards is President of the <u>Virginia Rail Policy Institute</u>, <u>Board Chair of the Rail</u> <u>Passengers Association</u>, and former President of <u>Virginians for High Speed Rail</u>.
