

SH -53 Pleasant View IC


- Project Identified in Bridging the Valley in Study June, 2006
- Design began 2006
- High priority for the ITD Director, construction advanced
- Funded through FRA RCE Grant
 - \$36 Million, 80% match
- Construction
 - Contractors bid \$28 Million
 - Work started September 30th
 - Anticipated completion November 2026
- Stakeholders
 - BNSF
 - Post Falls Highway District (PFHD)
 - FRA

Project Features

- Eliminate direct access from two side roads to State Highway
- Remove two at grade crossings, Prairie Ave and McGuire Rd
- Construct two bridges
 - One over BNSF tracks on Pleasant View Rd
 - One over the newly realigned State Highway to serve as an interchange









Outcomes

- Increased mobility for State Highway users to include freight movement.
- Safer access to highway system.
- Increased mobility for residents of Hauser and emergency services crossing BNSF tracks. Average 46 trains per day resulting in significant gate time.
- Less train noise for residents without crossings.
- Less disruptions to BNSF service.
- Currently an average of 14,400 vehicles use these crossings that will be consolidated onto the interchange.
